Responsibilities and duties of the Associate Market Strategist include:

- Provide macro-analytical support to the firm's investment and marketing teams
- Contribute written commentary and investment analyses to the firm's publicfacing publications, including its *Daily Comment*, *Bi-Weekly Geopolitical Report*, and *Bi-Weekly Asset Allocation* report
- Develop and deliver oral presentations to various audiences

Requirements. The candidate we seek would have the following:

- Expertise in global issues that can influence the performance of stocks, bonds, and alternative investments (such as geopolitics, national security policy, economics, trade, capital flows, demographics, technological developments, political and social trends, and financial market dynamics)
- Strong skills in both qualitative and quantitative analysis
- An interest in investments ranging from stocks and bonds to commodities (personal investment experience is preferred)
- An entrepreneurial attitude and capacity for independent learning
- Exceptional written and oral communications skills, including the ability to write short-to-medium length articles quickly, clearly, and concisely on tight deadlines
- High competence in Microsoft Excel, Word, and PowerPoint
- Familiarity with data analysis software such as Eviews, Macrobond, Haver Analytics, Bloomberg, and FRED is a plus

Other qualifications for this position are:

Bachelor's degree in finance, economics, international relations, history, or political science. Master's degree is preferred. Relevant work experience, particularly in intelligence analysis or financial journalism, will be considered in lieu of educational requirements.



The position will report directly to the Chief Market Strategist and work alongside members of the Macro team. The preferred location of this position is in our headquarters in St. Louis, MO, but we would consider a remote position in the Washington, DC, area. Some travel may be required.
