

Specialty Finance BDC • Alternative Investment Strategies

The Specialty Finance BDC strategy is focused on a niche of the financial sector known as business development companies, or BDCs. BDCs lend to and invest in the private debt and equity markets. The majority, if not all, of the portfolio holdings are in BDCs, typically involving 20-30 positions with a moderate level of turnover. This strategy is appropriate for clients seeking alternative investment exposure to the private markets, one that involves high levels of income from an equity portfolio with above-average volatility. Most of the portfolio income will be in the form of non-qualified dividends.

Market & Strategy Commentary

The Confluence Specialty Finance BDC strategy had a total return of 3.3% (gross of fees) in the third quarter of 2021, which was higher than the benchmark total return of 2.1% (the MVIS U.S. BDC Index). For the year-to-date period, the strategy is up 26.0% (gross of fees) versus the benchmark return of 30.1%. Meanwhile, the one-year return for the strategy is 53.1% (gross of fees) compared to 52.7% for the benchmark. [Net-of-fees returns for the same periods were +2.5% QTD, +23.2% YTD, and +48.6% trailing one-year. See disclosures on p.2 for fee description; actual investment advisory fees may vary.]

BDCs continued to deliver solid results in the third quarter. Operating results were generally good and BDC managers had active quarters underwriting large volumes of new loans, while also managing elevated levels of early payoffs. The large appetite for yield among debt investors is spilling into BDC lending markets, creating downward pressure on yields. However, many BDC managers have maintained attractive yield profiles in their loan portfolios by utilizing unique underwriting resources and by participating in the large demand for debt financing from private equity investors. Within the portfolio, BDC income remains in a healthy posture relative to dividends. As a result, dividend trends were quite positive in the third quarter. Seven BDCs raised their regular quarterly dividends, five special dividends were declared, 11 dividends were maintained, and no dividends were reduced. As a result, we continue to believe dividends are likely to constitute a significant proportion of the portfolio's total return in the future. The portfolio ended the quarter with an overall yield of 8.1%.

Portfolio Benchmark

The benchmark was changed prospectively starting 7/1/2021 as the prior benchmark, the Wells Fargo BDC Index (WFBDC), was discontinued in July 2021.

The U.S. Dollar is the currency used to express performance. Returns are presented gross and net of all fees and include the reinvestment of all income.

 ² Net-of-fee performance was calculated using the highest applicable annual bundled fee of 3.00% applied quarterly. This fee includes brokerage commissions, portfolio management, consulting services and custodial services. The Confluence fee schedule for this composite is as follows: 1.00% on the first \$500,000; 0.90% on the next \$500,000; and 0.75% over \$1,000,000. There are no incentive fees. Clients pay an all-inclusive fee based on a percentage of assets under management. The collection of fees produces a compounding effect on the total rate of return net of fees. Subsequent to February 1, 2013, bundled fee accounts make up 100% of the composite.

Actual investment advisory fees incurred by clients may vary. Wrap fee schedules are provided by independent wrap sponsors and are available upon request from the respective wrap sponsor. Performance prior to February 1, 2013, is based on the Specialty Finance BDC–Direct Composite which was created on December 1, 2011. The Specialty Finance BDC–Direct Composite includes accounts that pursue the Specialty Finance BDC strategy, but do not have bundled fees. Gross returns from the Specialty Finance BDC–Direct Composite include transaction costs and net-of-fee performance was calculated using the highest applicable annual bundled fee of 3.00% applied quarterly.

The annual composite dispersion is an equal-weighted standard deviation, using gross-of-fee returns, calculated for the accounts in the composite for the entire year. The three-year annualized standard deviation measures the variability of the composite or standard gross of-fee returns, calculated for the accounts in the composite for the entire year. The three-year annualized standard deviation measures the variability of the composite gross returns over the preceding 36-month period. The Specialty Finance BDC Composite contains fully discretionary Specialty Finance BDC wrap accounts. The Specialty Finance BDC portfolio invests primarily in Business Development Companies (BDCs) to earn current income with potential long-term capital appreciation.
